1. Chapters one to three describe **what we have in Christ** and **what Christ wants to be in us**. List chapter by chapter what you found to be the most important and useful discoveries you made:
 - what do I have in Christ?

 - what does Christ want to be in me?

2. Chapters four to six speak about different relationships we have in the church, in the family and in our society.
 - List these relationships

 - what does Paul foresee as the commonest difficulty in each relationship?

 - what in your experience is the biggest difficulty you see in those around you in this relationship?

3. Now take each of these relationships and their problems in turn and link to them something you have learned from chapters one to three about **us in Christ** and **Christ in us**.

4. Write a simple prayer which you might use with someone who is struggling in one of these ways by which they could apply the answer to the problem. What one word or phrase would you encourage them to keep in mind for such problems in the future?

5. What change, according to Paul, should you expect to see when someone has learned to trust Christ for each resource in each problem?

6. Having completed this study I would expect you still to have many unanswered questions. Write down one question for which you will be seeking an answer in future. How do you suppose God might answer this question for you?
