

FIJI ISLANDS – MUANICULA

Savusavu, Fiji is the location of Muanicula Discipleship School – a tropical paradise set in 7 acres of coconut plantation on the edge of a coral lagoon. Out on the reef are some rocky islands beyond which is the deep ocean. The planned programme here will be built on the same principles, emphasizing practical ministry and service growing from a closer understanding of the Bible. In such a beautiful setting there is plenty of opportunity for those who want to dive, snorkel or fish. Among the natural wonders live 'the friendliest people on earth' – the Fijians.



Muanicula has close links with the local villages and community where there are great avenues for outreach. The living conditions are simple, local style huts with kitchen, meeting room and a dining area which look out to the blue Pacific. The programme will be a new development to which we look set to welcome students from many parts of the world as well as Fiji. We hope to draw on teachers from New Zealand, Fiji and elsewhere.

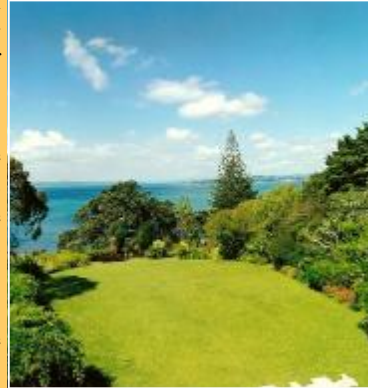

COSTS AND REQUIREMENTS

Admission to the course depends primarily on you sharing your call from God to be involved. We are not looking for qualifications but for an open heart to God's best. We will ask you to provide two references from pastors or Christian leaders who know you well and believe our course would suit you. If you are coming from overseas we believe you would find it helpful to try out some of the Bible courses on our website first to become familiar with our normal way of teaching. We particularly recommend starting with John's Gospel.

As already explained there is no charge for tuition. The cost of food and accommodation at Fowey Lodge is NZ\$160 per week. The cost at Muanicula is likely to be about the same but we will be able to give firmer details over the next few months as plans for the school there are settled.

BIBLE SCHOOL

Fowey Lodge in New Zealand, run by Dr Tony and Christine Hanne, has been operating as a short term Bible School since 1966, drawing around 3000 students from some 70 countries. The programme is built on some simple principles:



- The whole Bible is the inspired word of God.
- Its central theme is Jesus Christ, the Son of God. He wants to live in us as His Holy Spirit and be our teacher.
- Christian learning should show in one way above all – the unconditional love of God in our lives.
- Because God loves us, He gives His grace freely – it is therefore our privilege to offer Christian teaching without charge.
- Christian leadership is about serving, not dominating.

NEW ZEALAND – FOWEY LODGE

Fowey Lodge is set in 4 acres of gardens on a cliff top overlooking the beautiful, sheltered waters of the Hauraki Gulf. Accommodation for live-in students is comfortable in rooms which are usually shared by two students. Students are also welcome to live out among the local community. The Lodge is near popular beaches and the area is famous for recreational boating. The property has a tennis court with basketball and volleyball facilities.



The study courses are in four ten week blocks per year, each of which are followed by optional outreach and practical service opportunities in the community, particularly through our camp programme among young people. The course runs daily from Monday to Friday and includes morning and evening lectures, tutorial groups, internet resources, a library, time to pray and worship, private study time and much personal encouragement.

Fellowship and fun are central to our community. While we expect overseas students to study full-time we welcome local people to attend any part of our programme, although we recommend doing so on a regular basis throughout a term.

Having live-in students sharing in daily housework and the care of the buildings and gardens helps to keep costs down but it is also a healthy part of leadership training. There is opportunity for students who cannot afford the cost of accommodation at Fowey Lodge to work their way through by taking part in some extra work projects we undertake as a team.

You will enjoy meeting the Lodge ‘family’ which consists of a number of residential, long term families, an inspiring team of lecturers, many of whom have given their time to teaching our students for years, and a lovely group of practical helpers. Paul Crowhurst is our Bible School Principal. Alan Rorich is Academic Director. Tom and Margaret Ngapera are pastors. Nick Hanne is Outreach Director. Tony and Christine Hanne oversee the various ministries of the Lodge as a whole.

YOUTH MINISTRY AND CAMPS

We are closely linked with some very needy communities in which we will involve you according to your gifts and interests. We also have a strong commitment to working with children and young people both in regular clubs and in a camping programme. Camps include, in the summer, sailing, kayaking and various other water activities with tenting. In the winter we run ski camps, and in other seasons, adventure type activities in the unique New Zealand bush, mountains, lakes and rivers.
